Statement of Purpose: The Production and Regulatory Veterinarian will provide routine flock inspections, audits for biosecurity and welfare compliance, and all other internal duties to ensure health documentation for breeder chick and egg export requirements. The role serves Hy-Line International, Hy-Line North America, and Valo BioMedia North America from our production center at Dallas Center, Iowa.

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTIONS AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- Review & ensure the accuracy, and endorse export documentation for Hy-Line International, Hy-Line North America, and Valo BioMedia North America
- Monitor changes in foreign country import requirements and OIE regulations to ensure compliance
- Verify that all Hy-Line International and Valo flocks maintain relevant NPIP Qualifications and serve as a reference for internal laboratories for questions that arise regarding testing
- Conduct routine on-site breeder flock inspections to meet export requirements
- Monitor breeder flock performance data weekly including: feed consumption, water intake, egg production, and mortality
- Train employees to ensure compliance with biosecurity, welfare, sample collection, clinical observation, and management guidelines
- A integral member of the flock management team interacting regularly with production, hatchery, and research staff to troubleshoot and resolve issues related to bird health, management, welfare and biosecurity
- Conduct on-site facility inspections to audit biosecurity, welfare, and management programs to ensure QMS compliance and to identify new biosecurity threats
- Interpret serology, molecular, and bacteriological results from the Technical Services and Valo Laboratories
- With veterinary, production and research teams, develop preventive health care programs for all internal flocks
- Perform postmortem exams to monitor health status of flocks

- Assist in writing breeder and commercial layer management guides and technical updates
- Provide communication between internal, state, federal and academic veterinarians
- Work with a world-wide team of veterinary, management, hatchery and nutrition specialists
- Interact with other primary breeder veterinarians on common issues through the EW Group and Association of Poultry Primary Breeder Veterinarians (APPBV)
- Attend poultry technical meetings (IPPE/AVMA/AAAP and others) to stay current with the latest research and industry developments and trends
- Maintain USDA import permits needed to receive foreign tissue and blood samples
- Other duties as assigned
