Primary Function:

Maintain company flocks during life span with various task listed below.

Responsibilities/Duties:

- Catch, sort and examine chickens to ensure welfare of flocks
- Beak trim birds with operated machine to maintain welfare requirements
- Vaccinate chickens as required
- Draw and collect blood samples for flock data
- Discard flocks when required
- Document vaccination, blood testing, pedigree and production records
- Collect environmental sample swabs for lab tests
- Transport flocks to designated housing
- Wash and disinfect equipment daily and maintain clean environment
- Comply with OSHA, bio-security, and welfare regulations

Special knowledge, Skills, Licenses, Certifications:

- Knowledge and experience in agriculture
- Knowledge and environmental health issues pertaining to livestock
