Position Title: Wash Crew Technician

Primary Function:

Will be responsible to operate power washer and related equipment to remove manure, dirt, debris, and staining within animal production facilities and animal transportation vehicles.

Responsibilities/Duties:

- Operate pressure washer machinery safely and effectively to clean a variety of surfaces
- Maintain established schedule as requested and provide feedback to improve schedule efficiency
- Load and affix pressure washing equipment to truck and trailers as required
- Fill tanks with fuel, water, and chemicals as required
- Erect scaffolding and ladders as needed
- Properly dispose of/remove waste water and barricade necessary drains
- Clean up rubble, debris and other waste materials from area being washed
- Read plans, instructions, or specifications to determine work activities
- Keep tools and equipment in good repair
- Must be willing to travel with the pressure washing equipment to all Hy-Line International and N.A. owned facilities
- Other manual duties as directed
- Responsible to work with other departments (hatchery, flock service, research) during washing downtime
- Comply with OSHA, bio-security, and welfare regulations
- Maintain PPE and safe working environment

Special knowledge, Skills, Licenses, Certifications:

- Knowledge and environmental health issues pertaining to application of disinfectants and chemicals

Physical Requirements:
